Our topic after half term in Year 2 is Explorers. To support the children's further understanding we will be visiting The Mary Rose in Portsmouth Dockyard on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February.

We will be leaving on the 09:47 Fast Cat (Children will need to be at the wet end of the pier at 09:30) and returning on the 14:15 from Portsmouth (Children will need to be collected from the wet end of the pier at 14:30.)

The children will learn about life on board the Mary Rose. We will have a tour around the Mary Rose and will attend the workshop 'Henry's Heroes.' Children will discover what life was like above and below deck on King Henry VIII's favourite warship. We will get to handle a range of replica artefacts and the children will get to dress up in some of the replica Tudor clothing.

The cost of the trip is £16 per child, (this is non-refundable). We would be grateful if this could be paid online via School Money by Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February. Once payment is received this will confirm your consent for your child to attend the trip but I will also need you to complete the attached EV3 and return completed and signed no later than Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February.
