SCIENCE

The children will continue their learning about plants, including answering questions such as: Does a seed contain a miniature plant that can develop into a fully grown plant? Does a bulb have underground vertical shoots which alreadu have modified leaves? Do seeds and bulbs need water to grow? Do seeds and bulbs have food stores inside them to help the plant start to grow?

HISTORY
