SCIENCE

The children will be answering the question

What is a habitat?

The children will identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. The children will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants – including trees. The children will also learn there is **variation** in all living things. That animals and plants live in a variety of different places called **habitats**. The children will learn how animals and plants have **adapted** to survive in different habitats. **Wild plants** such as ferns, daisies, nettles and dandelions grow randomly. **Garden plants** such as roses, tulips, poppies, daffodils are planted intentionally

History

The children will be answering the question;

Was Dickie Dawes really a pirate?

They will be learning about Pirates and will be answering questions such as Who were pirates? How is life different for a pirate to yours? What is the same/different?

What is the difference between a pirate, smuggler and a wrecker? Why did smuggling happen on the Isle of Wight? Did smuggling have an impact on the Isle of Wight? Who was Dickie Dawes? Why do we remember him? How do we know about him?

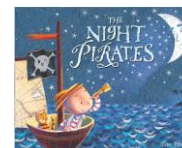
DT and MUSIC

- Numbers to 100 – counting from 50 to 100, counting in 10's to 100, using numberlines to 100, one more and one less, comparing numbers
- Money
- Time
