SCIENCE - We will be looking at some elements of Living things and their habitats as well as Animals including Humans. The children will learn what a habitat is and the children will focus on the seaside/ocean habitats. Looking at which animals habitats these are and food chains for some animals found in the seas/seaside. They will be able to identify what predators and prey are at the seaside.

GEOGRAPHY, HISTORY

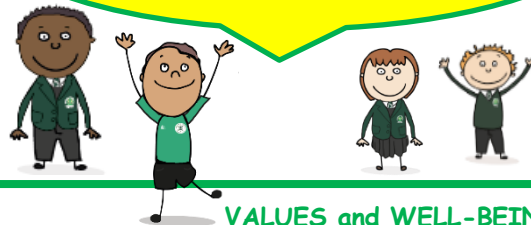
In Geography the children will be developing their map work skills linking this to our local area and creating maps for the local area and school. They will also be developing their maps skills focusing on the UK looking at the countries that make up the UK, the capital cities and the seas that surround the UK. In History we will be looking at how the Isle of Wight has changed over the years, How seaside holidays have changed over the decades? Key questions the children will look at are What are the countries that make up the UK? What was the seaside like in the past?

ART, DT and MUSIC

In art the children will be looking at the sculptor Andy Goldsworthy and will create sculptures in his style. They will also learn sketching and shading techniques to help with their drawing. In DT the children will be working with levers and creating a moving picture as well as looking at healthy eating and creating their own healthy snack. In Music we will be learning to compose our own music as well as listening and appraising pieces of music we listen to. We will add our own compositions to a piece of music that we listen to in class.

*Tolerance of those with Different Faiths and Beliefs.

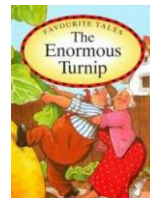
ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES The children will go on a walk around the village and to Sandown beach to see what physical and human features they can see.

COMPUTING - We will be looking at using the program Paint to help us create art work on the computer. We will also use Ipad's and cameras to take and edit photos.

OUR TEXT-DRIVER -The Enormous Turnip, The Giant Carrot, The Enormous Potato and The Snail and the Whale.



ENGLISH - This half term we will be looking at Traditional Tales and Alternative tales as well as some texts linked to our topic of the seaside. We will be looking at The Enormous Turnip, The Giant Carrot by Allan Manham, The Enormous Potato by Aubrey Davis and The Snail and Whale by Julia Donaldson. We will also look at and comparing the books Grandma bird and The Storm Whale by Benji Davies for our Whole Class Guided Reading. The children will be using these texts to help them create both fiction and non-fiction texts this term.

MATHS This term in maths we will be looking at Place Value, Addition and Subtraction and Money. In Place Value we will be looking at counting, ordering, reading and writing numbers to 100 using practical strategies like a number line and 100 square. In addition and subtraction, we will use different strategies to add and subtract. Money will focusing on value of coins and making given amounts
