GEOGRAPHY, HISTORY and SPANISH


In History, we will be continuing to learn about the Ancient Egyptians so that we can answer the big question Who were better builders - Egyptians or Bronze Age Britons?

<u>ENGLISH</u>

In doing this we will explore the different vocabulary that can be used and going on an imaginary guided tour of the forest setting. We will be writing a description of the forest setting during the day and the night, conveying different viewpoints.

We will also enjoy reading novels of our choice from our book corner as well as our library. We will be listening to a story read aloud on a daily basis.

MATHS

This term our focus will be on perimeter, fractions, length, capacity and mass. The learning of these skills will involve using mathematical equipment, diagrams and efficient methods. We will be applying these to problem solving.
