



## LEARNING IN YEAR 3 IS THE PLACE TO BE!

### SCIENCE

In Science this half term, we will be investigating animals, including humans. We will be taking a look at nutrition, understanding different animals' diets, why animals have different diets and why good nutrition is essential for good health. We will investigate what makes a healthy diet and how food provides a source of energy. We will also be learning about the digestive system, understanding how and where food is digested and the journey it takes through our body. We will focus particularly on different types of teeth and their roles, the stomach and intestines.

### GEOGRAPHY, HISTORY and SPANISH


This half term we will be focussing on physical Geography. We will start by understanding what is under the Earth's surface by creating a model of the Earth from the core to the crust. We will then investigate earthquakes, tornadoes and tsunamis, focussing on how and where these may occur.

### ART, DT and MUSIC

In Music we will be learning to play the Glockenspiel.

In DT, we will be making pizzas. We will start by writing a recipe, we will then make the dough using our own recipe. Whilst the dough is proving, we will design our pizzas using creative patterns that make us happy. We will then top our pizzas with tomato sauce, cheese and our chosen toppings, ready to be cooked!

### OUR TEXT-DRIVER

The Hundred-Mile-An-Hour Dog by Jeremy Strong.

### ENGLISH

Our text driver is about an untrained, mischievous dog named Streaker, who causes havoc in her household with her cheeky ways. The main character, Trevor, is tasked with the job of training Streaker in the Easter holidays. We will be using this book to inspire our writing skills, with our main focus being Streaker. We will be analysing Streaker and creating a character profile using the information we learn from the book. We will then begin to plan and write about Streaker, implementing different skills we learn along the way including a variety of new vocabulary, punctuation and sentence types. Finally, we will write a newspaper report about Streaker's disastrous trip to the local market.

### MATHS

In Maths this half term we will be practising our addition and subtraction techniques using 3-digit numbers. We will then move onto Geometry where we will look at types of angles and how to calculate the perimeter of a shape. We will also be practising our division and multiplication techniques for our 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. Finally, we will be learning about measurements of volume and capacity, including litres and millilitres.
