SCIENCE – We will be continuing our science topic - digestion. The children will learn about the different types of teeth and their jobs as well as teeth and food chains in animals. They will conclude the digestion topic by looking at the different parts and organs that make up our digestive system and their roles.

OUR TEXT-DRIVER – La Luna a Pixar video clip. Our class novel will be Queen of Darkness by Tony Badman.

ENGLISH – This half term we will be looking at the Pixar film La Luna. The children will be using film to help them create a dialogue. For our Whole Class Guided Reading we will be looking at a range of different texts focusing on the birds, Chinese New Year, Awesome stories, National story telling week and Children's Mental Health week. Our class novel this term will be Queen of Darkness by Tony Badman.

MATHS - This term in maths we will be looking at Multiplication and Division, length and perimeter and Fractions. The children will look at multiplying and dividing by 0, 1, 10 and 100 as well as 3,6,7,11 and 12. As well as factor pairs and multiplying and dividing by 2 and 3 digits.

HOME LEARNING Please continue to support your child in their home learning which will be uploaded onto their Seesaw activities on a Friday and is due in on a Wednesday. The home learning this term will be in relation to what we are learning in class. Reading homework should happen every night for a minimum of 10 minutes and recorded on your child's GoRead account. We also recommend children practise the Y3/4 Common Exception words and their times tables.

History – During this half term the children will be learning about the Roman Empire. The children will create timelines of key events during this period as well as looking at key significant figures and the lifestyles of Romans. They will learn why and how the Romans invaded England and where the Roman Empire settled as well as where they came from. The children will learn about Boudicca's rebellion as well as how the Romans shaped our lives today and how they changed in Britain.

Art, Spanish and Music - In Art we will be looking at the artist Sonia Delaunay. The children will discuss what they like about her art work and learn about her work on rhythm and orphism art and create their own fashion piece in Sonia's style. Their final piece will be either a 2D or 3D piece of art work in memory of Sonia and to honour her. In Music we will be learning to play the recorder the children will learn to play certain notes and play familiar tunes before composing their own pieces of music. In Spanish the children will be learning to say when our birthday is and also practising ordering food in a cafe.

VALUES and WELL-BEING

COMPUTING – Children will be looking at Repetition in Shape. The unit will look at repetition and loops within programming. The children will create programs by planning, modifying and testing commands to create shapes and patterns. They will use Logo a text-based programming language.
