SCIENCE

We will be continuing with our theme of Animals, including humans. We will be constructing and interpreting a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey. Describing the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans. Identifying the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

GEOGRAPHY and SPANISH

In Geography we are learning about features of the UK.

Key questions:

What is the difference between the British Isles, Great Britain and U.K? What does the UK actually look like? Where is the Isle of Wight in the UK? What are the countries in the UK? What is a county? Which county do I live in? What is the UK like? What is the Isle of Wight like?

In Spanish, we will participate in songs and play games based on vocabulary naming parts of the body. We will ask questions about a person's appearance and understand the answer. We will write one or more short sentences to describe a person's appearance. We will read and understand a short passage relating to a person's appearance.

ART, DT and MUSIC

We will be learning about origami and participating in the our KS2 production. In Music, we will be learning new music and songs for our KS2 production.


COMPUTING Creating media- photo editing. We will be changing images and changing the compositions.

ENGLISH

This is a story that shows that a relationship with nature is essential to every human being, and that now, more than ever, we need to renew that relationship.

We will focus on writing letters, recounts of events and a persuasive argument to encourage the planter to visit a city and improve the environment.

We will also enjoy reading novels of our choice from the new books provided for our class library, as well as listening to a story read aloud on a daily basis.

MATHS

We will be finding the effect of dividing a one- or two-digit number by 10 and 100. Recognise and write decimal equivalents to $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$.

Compare and classify geometric shapes, including quadrilaterals based on their properties and sizes. Identify acute and obtuse angles. Complete a simple symmetric figure with respect to a specific line of symmetry. Describe positions on a 2-D grid as co-ordinates. Find the area of rectilinear shapes by counting squares. The learning of these skills will involve using mathematical equipment, diagrams and efficient methods. We will be applying these to problem solving.
