SCIENCE



History and SPANISH

ENGLISH

It is 1922, and Howard Carter has returned to the Valley of the Kings in Egypt, searching for the treasure of King Tutankhamun. The main character in the story is Ali who is employed as a water carrier, he stumbles upon something amazing. Has Ali found the entrance to the Pharaoh's tomb? We discover the character of Ali; write newspaper reports and write another fascinating adventure.

We will also enjoy reading novels of our choice from the new books provided for our class library, as well as listening to a story read aloud on a daily basis

MATHS

We will be representing multiplication and division facts as arrays using a grid (rather than dots) and on a number-line. Multiplying two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number. In division we will be learning how to divide where there will be a remainder as well as dividing 2-digit and 3-digit numbers without remainders. We will add and subtract with numbers up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction where appropriate. Estimate and use inverse operations to check answers to a calculation Solve addition and subtraction two-step problems in contexts, deciding which operations and methods to use and why. The learning of these skills will involve using mathematical equipment, diagrams and efficient methods. We will be applying these to problem solving.
