## SCIENCE

In Science, we will be finishing exploring the fun question: 'How are new substances made?', before moving on to look at Forces that Oppose Motion, where the big question is, 'How and why do things move?'

PSHE and RSE Using our 'SCARF' resource, we will explore Rights and Responsibilities. Through our assemblies we will continue to develop our awareness of the protected characteristics and our school learning principles.

## GEOGRAPHY, HISTORY and SPANISH

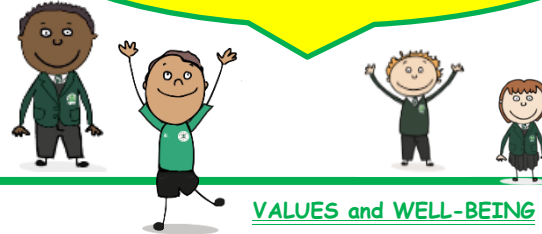

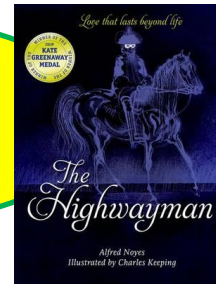
## RE

## OUR TEXT-DRIVERS

'The Highwayman'

## ENGLISH

This half term, our learning journey will centre around Alfred Noyes' narrative poem, 'The Highwayman'. We will watch an animated version of the poem, as well as exploring sections of the text in depth. Children will use drama to develop Speaking and Listening skills, and to stimulate ideas for writing. We will have fun writing in role as characters within the poem and explore the use of rich descriptive language. Children will additionally be working extremely hard to improve their accuracy in spelling and punctuation, as well as reading comprehension skills.

## MATHS

We will continue to build our Fluency skills daily, as well as progressing through Power Maths. We will be looking at multiplying by two digit numbers and also dividing numbers with up to four digits by a single digit (including where there are remainders). We will build on last term's fractions learning -exploring multiplying fractions, as well as learning about decimals and percentages.

Please continue to support your child in completing their home learning using Seesaw and any other resources provided. This will be set on a Friday and is due in on a Wednesday. Learning will include Maths, Reading and Spelling/Grammar. Please ensure reading is recorded on Go Read and also please support your child in regularly revising their times tables learning.
