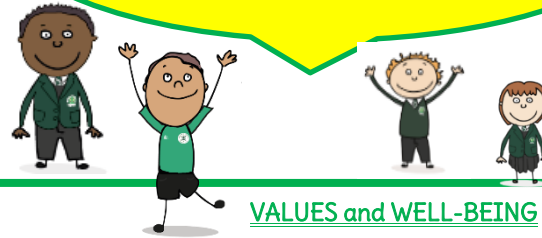
In History, we will be thinking about the Vikings, Anglo Saxons and Scots with a focus on the question, 'Did they get on?'

The Island by Armin Greder

ENGLISH This half term our learning journey will be based on the stunning picture book, 'The Island', by Armin Greder. We will explore this through discussion and drama and use it as inspiration for creating dialogues, which we will perform to other members of the school community to encourage reflection on Diversity and Tolerance. We will continue to be working extremely hard to use a variety of sentence lengths and structures, and to improve our accuracy in spelling and punctuation, through effectively editing our writing. In our reading activities, we will be building vocabulary, and improving prosody and comprehension.

MATHS

We will continue our daily fluency work and Power Maths. Areas of learning we will tackle include decimals and percentages and measuring area and perimeter. We will solve problems using fractions, decimals and percentages, as well as reading, writing, ordering and comparing numbers up to three decimal places and recognizing equivalence between fractions, decimals and percentages.
