SCIENCE

In Science, we will finish our 'Forces that Oppose Motion' learning journey, where we will continue to investigate how and why things move. We will then be learning about Circulation. Both of these units will provide many exciting opportunities to develop our practical skills as scientists.

HISTORY and SPANISH

ENGLISH This half term our learning journey will be based on Robert Macfarlane and Jackie Morris' beautiful poetry anthology: The Lost Words. We will use this as a stimulus for composing poetry of our own in a similar style, as well as applying previously taught skills to write a fun persuasive letter in role as one of the creatures described within the anthology. We will continue to be working extremely hard to improve our accuracy in spelling and punctuation, and applying this in effectively editing our writing. Through our reading activities, including use of the Fred's Teaching reading resource, we will be building vocabulary, and improving prosody and comprehension.

MATHS

We will continue to be busy both consolidating skills and carrying out new learning in Maths this half term. Areas of learning we will tackle include: extending learning on decimals; converting units of measurement; shape -including properties of irregular shapes, angles, and calculating volume; position and direction working out where shapes will end up on a grid after translations, as well as interpreting line graphs.
